Food Stamp Employment and Training Referrals

Overview

The Farm Bill of 2002 significantly reduced funding for the Food Stamp Employment and Training Program (FS/ET). As a result, the Department is currently negotiating the terms of a new contract for FS/ET services with DET.

This Field Operations Memo instructs AU Managers to stop making referrals to DET Job Search for nonexempt FS E/T participants and voluntary FS Work Program participants.

Instructions

Effective immediately, AU Managers must stop referring nonexempt FS/ET participants and voluntary FS Work Program participants to DET Job Search using either a BEACON-generated referral form or a manual referral form.

Until further notice, all nonexempt FS/ET participants must meet the self-directed job search requirements at 106 CMR 362.310(D).
