A change in legislation has instituted an asset limit of \$2000 for EAEDC clients residing in Living Arrangement E, a licensed rest home, also known as a residential care facility. Assets include but are not limited to bank accounts, personal property, real estate, the cash surrender value of life insurance, cash on hand and bank deposits.

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**Purpose**

The purpose of this Online Guide Transmittal is to inform staff of the new asset limit of \$2000 for EAEDC rest home residents and steps to verify assets.
