Re: TAFDC - Clothing Allowance, September 2014

Overview

The Department will issue a nonrecurring clothing allowance of \$150 per eligible TAFDC client under the age of 19 for September 2014.

Purpose of Memo

This Operations Memo advises DTA staff about:

- who is eligible;
- payment amounts;
- payment dates; and
- notices.

Who is Eligible

All TAFDC clients under age 19 who are active on September 1, 2014 or TAFDC-eligible during the month of September 2014 are eligible for a clothing allowance. A child born after the family cap date is ineligible for a clothing allowance, unless a waiver or exception of the family cap rule has been granted by September 30, 2014. Children receiving SSI are not eligible for a clothing allowance.

The clothing allowance is prorated for clients under the age of 19 with an eligibility start date after September 1, 2014.

Increased Standards

Refer to the mass.gov/dta website and select the Program Eligibility Charts and Tables link under Key Resources to view the Eligibility, Need and Payment Standards for the month of September. The figures are available with the publication of this Operations Memo.

Eligibility standards are increased by \$277.50, and Need and Payment standards are increased by \$150 for each eligible applicant and client under age 19.

In October 2014, the standards will return to the regular amounts. BEACON will automatically recalculate client eligibility and send notices to those no longer eligible for TAFDC benefits.

September Applications

BEACON will perform an eligibility test for all applicants who are approved for TAFDC after September 1, 2014 using the lower August 2014 eligibility standards. If the applicant is ineligible using the lower standards, BEACON will perform a second test of eligibility using the higher September 2014 standards. If the applicant passes this second test, BEACON will issue a payment for a portion of the \$150 amount per eligible client under age 19.

The following informational message will appear on the Interview Wrapup EBC Results page for these cases:

"This AU is not eligible for TAFDC using the regular Standard of Need, but is eligible for a Clothing Allowance in the amount of \$XXX.XX."

Amounts

A payment (separate from the semi-monthly payment) is issued for:

- \$150 per eligible client under age 19 on September 1, 2014; or
- a prorated amount per eligible client under age 19, if eligible for part of September 2014.

Clients receiving payments through direct deposit will have the clothing allowance payment deposited into their bank account.

Clients receiving payments through EBT will have the clothing allowance payment deposited into their EBT account.

Payment Dates

The clothing allowance payment will be available to clients according to the following chart:

| Benefit Available | Payment Type | Ending SSN |
|-------------------|----------------|------------|
| 08/ 30 /2014 | Direct Deposit | 0 to 9 |
| 08/30/2014 | EBT | 0 to 9 |

Supplemental payments will be available on September 19, October 17, November 21 and December 19 (notices should arrive on or about those dates) to households with eligible clients under age 19 who become eligible during the month of September 2014 and are approved on the dates in the chart below:

| For clients who become eligible during September and are approved | the supplemental clothing allowance will be available on: |

These clients may receive a full or prorated amount of the clothing allowance, depending on their date of application or eligibility. The date and amount of the clothing allowance may be found by accessing the Benefit History tab for the appropriate case.

Notices

Clients eligible on September 1 will be sent a notice (Attachment A) on August 29, 2014.

For clients eligible after September 1, notices (Attachment B) will be sent to households with eligible clients under 19 years old who become eligible during the month of September 2014 and who will receive a full or prorated amount of the clothing allowance on either September 19, October 17, November 21 or December 19, 2014.
