TAFDC – Stopping the BEACON Participation Sanction Batch Job

### **Participation Sanction Batch** Job

#### **Effective immediately:**

- 1). a Work Program required recipient participating in an ESP activity or working (including Work Program Alternatives);
- 2). an exempt teen parent not meeting the school attendance requirement; or
- 3). a categorically ineligible noncitizen who is exempt and required to participate in community service,

who does not return the Participation and Attendance form or who does not meet the required hours for participation will **not** be sanctioned.

To ensure that these recipients receive the Good Cause Warning Notice before being sanctioned, the BEACON Participation sanction process is being halted until adjustments can be made.

AU Managers are still responsible to enter the information from the Participation and Attendance form onto BEACON. AU Managers must not sanction these recipients manually if they fail the hourly participation level.

# Participation Sanction Batch Job (Continued)

AU Managers are also reminded that the sanction process for Work Program required recipients who are <u>not</u> participating in an ESP activity or working as detailed in Field Operations Memo 2004-37 A is still in effect.

TAO staff will be informed when the BEACON Participation sanction process resumes.
