From the Hotline

- Q Can we give child care to a teen parent who is not eligible because she is an ineligible citizen?
- A No. We cannot give child care to grantees ineligible for categorical reasons.
- Q If the father of a child not included in the assistance unit because of the family cap provision, returns to the home and the father does not meet the requirements to be considered either unemployed or incapacitated, how do we aid this case?
- A In this case, the family cap child lacks a deprivation factor needed for TAFDC. Therefore, this would be an EAEDC case aiding the father and that child in Living Arrangement B.
- Q Do we still sanction recipients who do not go on direct deposit?
- A No. With EBT now statewide, no recipients live in nonEBT areas. See 106 CMR 204.550.
