Re:

Revised EA Eligibility Standard

Overview

The FY03 budget requires a change in the EA Eligibility Standard which is to be based on 100 percent of the Federal Poverty Level. The current EA Eligibility Standard is based on 130 percent of the Federal Poverty Level. As of 7/30/2002, the revised EA Eligibility Standard must be used for new or pending EA applications in determining eligibility for EA benefits.

The FY03 Budget also eliminated rental arrearage payments and disaster benefits from the EA program.

Revised EA Eligibility Standard The EA Eligibility Standard based on 100 percent of the Federal Poverty Level is:

Processing EA Applications

Until the EA Eligibility Standard in BEACON is adjusted to the lower amounts, AU Managers must determine the financial eligibility manually by using the amounts in the table on the prior page for any new or pending EA application. If the AU's countable monthly income exceeds the EA Eligibility Standard for an AU of its size, complete the NFL-9 to deny benefits because "the monthly income exceeds the EA Eligibility Standard for an assistance unit of its size". Manual citation is 106 CMR 309.020.

Ongoing EA AUs

At this time, AU Managers are not to reevaluate the financial eligibility of active EA AUs assigned to them. Staff will be advised if they need to take additional action.

Regulations

EA policy regulations have been revised to reflect the lowered standard and the elimination of rental arrearage and disaster benefits. State Letter 1230 which contains these changes will be shipped as soon as possible.
