Re:	Cross Programs – Suspected of Living Above Means (SLAM) Procedural Clarifications	
Overview	When a SLAM circumstance becomes apparent, staff must explore with the household how it is managing its finances. Staff must compare the information a client provides with the information known to the Department and request additional verification, if needed.	
Purpose	 The purpose of this Transmittal is to obsolete OLGT 2017-71 and to advise staff of revised Online Guide content, including: how to address SLAM circumstances based on where the household is in its SNAP certification period; and the user-generated verification items related to SLAM— Living Above Means, Past Due Housing Costs, and Past Due Utilities.
