Re:	TAFDC – Family Cap Rules Edits		
Overview	A child born after a case's Family Cap date must not be added to the TAFDC case without an exception or waiver.		
	BEACON enhancements have been scheduled for production effective 10/02/2017 to uphold Family Cap policy at reapplication and reinstatement.		
Purpose	 This Online Guide Transmittal advises staff about a revised Online Guide page underscoring the BEACON enhancements, which are: a pop-up edit that displays on the Apply for Assistance page when a child born after the Family Cap date is being added to the case; a modification that requires TAO manager level approval on the Interview Wrapup Authorization page when a child born after the Family Cap date is being approved in the case; and a hard edit that prevents an Interview Wrapup that excludes from the case, a child born after the family cap date, who has an exception or waiver.
