SNAP: Simplified Reporting - Elderly Disabled Simplified Application Project (EDSAP Reporting) Online Guide Updates

Overview Simplified Reporting is a certification type that allows DTA to more efficiently administer SNAP and for clients to receive stable benefits. In December 2018, Simplified Reporting was expanded to include two new Simplified Reporting certification types: EDSAP Reporting and Simplified Reporting (Former EDSAP). EDSAP provides clients with a Simplified Reporting period of 36-months, limited reporting requirements, and the waiving of the Interim Report (IR) requirement. Simplified Reporting the opportunity to complete the EDSAP certification period with limited reporting requirements. In response to feedback received from field staff, updates to the Online Guide have been made.

PurposeThe purpose of this Online Guide Transmittal is to advise staff of updates
made to the Online Guide. These updates include:

• all households converted to EDSAP in December 2018 or March 2019 will now display the EDSAP certification type in the Updates tab;

Purpose (cont.)	 enhanced certification types reference chart; noncountable income clarification; and procedures for processing Interim Reports that are no longer required 	
Implementation	Some cases that were converted to EDSAP in December 2018 did not reflect this change under their certification type. Effective March 29, 2019, a number of cases have been recalculated to ensure that certification dates and certification types are consistent across all applicable BEACON pages. Households converted to EDSAP Reporting or Simplified Reporting (Former EDSAP) as part of this automatic recalculation and release were sent a non- EBC conversion notice alerting the household to the change in their certification type and new reporting requirements.
