Re:	SNAP: How to Determine Disability When a Client is No Longer Receiving SSA Payments		
Overview	There are times when a client is no longer receiving SSI and/or RSDI payments but is still considered federally-disabled by the Social Security Administration (SSA).		
	If a client is not actively receiving SSA payments, but a disability onset date is present on the External SSA Data screen, you must explore if the client is still considered disabled by looking at the client's Pay Status.		
Purpose	This Transmittal advises staff that the SNAP Disability Requirements and Verifications Online Guide page has been updated to assist staff in determining a disability status when SSI and/or RSDI payments for disability.
