Re: SNAP: Asset Limit Increase for Elderly/Disabled Households

Overview

Pursuant to the 2008 Farm Bill, the asset limit for SNAP households that include an elderly (age 60 or older) or disabled member has increased from

\$3,000 to \$3,250. This change is retroactive to October 1, 2011.

Purpose The purpose of this memo is to inform staff of the asset limit change for

elderly or disabled SNAP households.

BEACON Update The new asset limit of \$3250 was programmed into BEACON over the

weekend of January 7, 2012.

Case Manager Responsibilities An MIS query showed that since October 1, 2011, no applicant or existing client was denied or terminated SNAP benefits because of assets exceeding

the former limit of \$3,000.

No case manager action is required.
