RE: MEDEX Premium Rate Changes for NPA Food Stamps
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Introduction Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Massachusetts has announced premium rate changes to four non-group plans, Gold, Standard, Core and Silver. There are no rate changes to the Bronze or Basic plans. These changes were effective as of January 1995.

- identifies the plans that have changed and the corresponding rate changes and those that have not changed;
