Re: TAFDC: Living Arrangement Requirements for Parents Under The Age

Of 20

Overview

On February 1, 2024, the Department issued Online Guide Transmittal 2024-7: Cross Program: Language Updates for TAFDC parents who have additional requirements due to their age. These requirements include both school and special living arrangement requirements. Some additional questions regarding the rules for parents under 20 to be allowed to live independently have come up.

Purpose

The purpose of this Online Guide Transmittal is to advise staff of changes made to the Online Guide to clarify living arrangement requirements for parents under the age of 20.

Key Clarifications

Two key areas where questions have come up have been addressed in the Online Guide updates:

- Parents age 18 and 19 do not need to be assessed by DCF in order to live independently and;
- DCF Independent Living Recommendation requirements only apply to parents under the age of 18.
