Medex Premium Rate Changes

Introduction

Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Massachusetts has announced Medex premium rate changes to six non-group plans, Basic, Bronze, Gold, Standard, Core and Silver. These changes were effective February 1, 2001.

This memo:

- identifies the plans that have changed and the corresponding rate changes;
- identifies the date of the changes and the effect these changes will have on the amount of food stamp benefits;
- transmits information for the Medex Premium Rate Update Report;

Identifying Recipients Enrolled in Medex

Reminder: AU Managers are advised of the importance of identifying recipients enrolled in Medex. To ensure AU accuracy and the correct calculation of food stamp benefits, Medex premium payments must be entered on the PACES Worksheet using the proper code. Refer to the PACES User's Guide, Chapter IV: PACES Worksheet for complete information on the Med Prem and Cd fields displayed in the FIW1 Section of the Worksheet.

Updated PACES Screens

Several PACES screens have been updated with the new food stamp benefit amount and/or new Medex premium amount as follows:

- the new food stamp benefit amount will be displayed on the PACES
 Case Data Screen (RECD) for non-pended transactions and on the
 Cases Pending Report Screen (PRPT) for pended transactions.
- the new Medex premium amount will be displayed on the Financial Data Screen (GRT1) for non-pended transactions and on the Pending FIW1 Screen (PIW1) for pended transactions.
